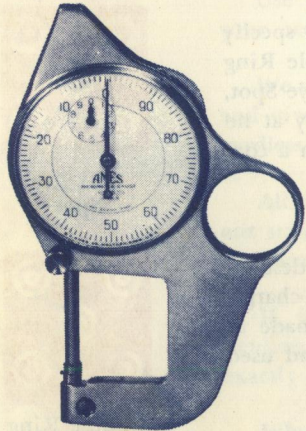




DICE MEASURING TOOLS

Precision dice measuring tools are a necessity for every operator of a dice game. Regardless of the care exercised in selecting your dice, the precision tools listed below will help you to properly protect your game.

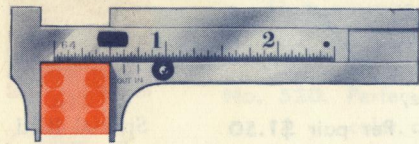
PERFECTION DIAL MICROMETER



This is the newest, fastest and most accurate tool ever devised for measuring dice. This measuring instrument is rugged in construction and not affected by wear, yet extremely sensitive. The quick acting spindle is lifted by pressing the knurled wheel with the thumb in an upward motion. Releasing the thumb allows the spindle to close on the dice to be measured. The spindle can be locked in any position and used as a snap gauge for the "Texas Mike" dice test. Thousandths of an inch are enlarged by spaced graduations on the dial permitting readings of one-tenth of a thousandth with no possibility of an error.

SLIDE CALIPER

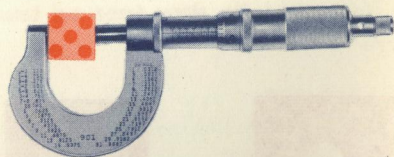


This is a fairly accurate tool for quick measurements. Equipped with a lock-nut, it shows variations to 1/64 of an inch. Made of hardened tool steel and easily carried in vest pocket.

MICROMETER CALIPER

In the hands of a man mechanically inclined this tool is actually the most accurate hand tool made. This micrometer is fitted with a ratchet stop preventing injury to dice by pressure. Shows variations to one ten thousandth of an inch. Made of the best materials obtainable.



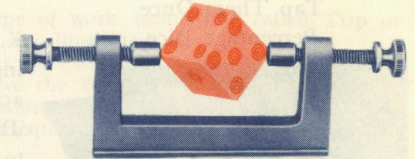

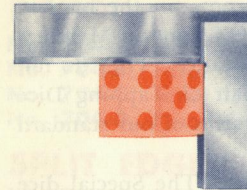
BALANCING CALIPER

A new tool which will immediately detect a weighted dice regardless of how light the weight may be. Fast in action with absolute accuracy, this is a tool needed by every dice man. Chrome finish with case hardened pivot joints.

KNIFE EDGE SQUARE

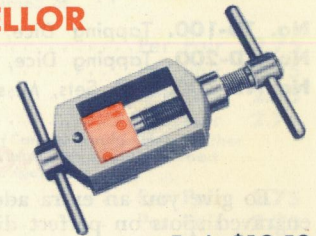


Dice may caliper perfect and still be out of square. This tool is made of case hardened tool steel and is as accurate as a pocket square can be made. The proper method in testing dice for squareness with a knife square is diagonally from corner to corner as illustrated.

MONOGRAM CANCELLOR

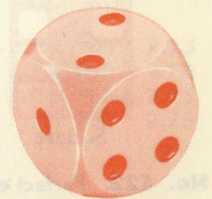
A practical tool for cancelling monograms, initials, or marks on dice when dice are given away to players. This tool prevents the dice from again being used in the game at another time.
